Content of the exam:

The examination covers the content of the lecture “Compound Semiconductors and Optical Components” as held in WS 2025/2026.

Grading:

- Drawings require appropriate coordinate systems.
- All notations/symbols introduced by you have to be properly defined.
- Numerical results are only valid with appropriate dimensions.

Attempts to use prohibited tools/help (including cell phones or outside communication) is automatically leading to “failed” grading
